The National Inquiry into Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls Community Hearings of the Truth Gathering Process

Moncton, New Brunswick – February 13-14, 2018

Commissioner Michèle Audette will be in Moncton, New Brunswick for Community Hearings from February 13-14, 2018. The daily hearings are expected to begin at 9:00 AM AST and are scheduled to end at 5:00 PM AST each day. Approximately 20 family members and survivors are expected to share their truths. There are a variety of ways to provide testimony throughout the week - public and private hearings, artistic expression panels and through statement gatherers.

The Commissioners' mandate is to examine and report on the systemic causes of all forms of violence against Indigenous women, girls and LGBTQ2S people in Canada by looking at patterns and underlying factors. The mandate also includes examining institutional practices and policies implemented in response to violence experienced by Indigenous women and girls, including examining police investigation practices and responses, as part of this public investigation.

Anyone from the public can attend the community hearings to observe in the public hearing rooms. Alternatively, the hearings will be live streamed. Links will be posted on our website and Facebook page.
