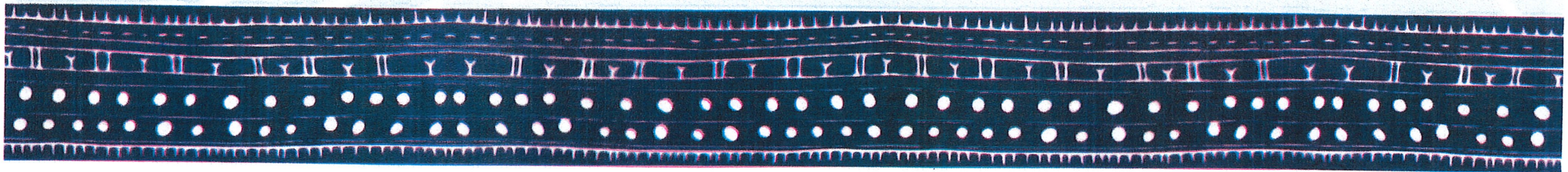


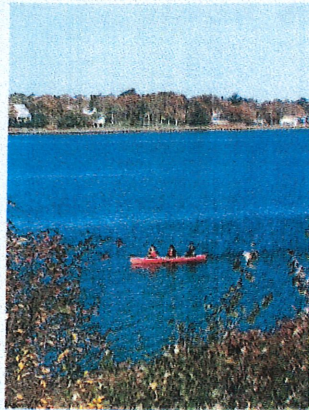
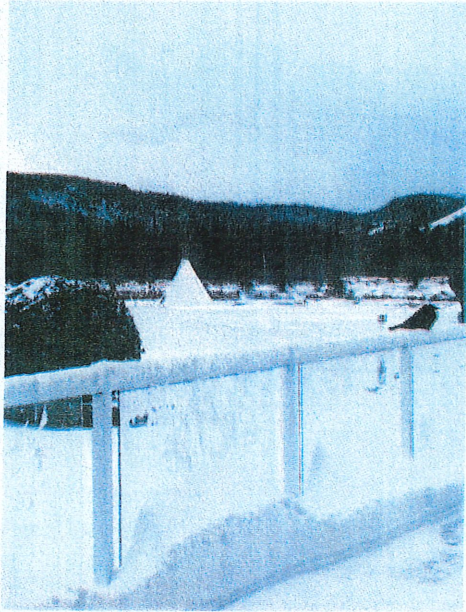


Hearings
