St. John's, NL – The National Inquiry into Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls would like to thank the Mi'kmag for welcoming us on their ancestral homelands and the homelands of the Beothuk. There we gathered from October 15 to 18, 2018, to hold a Knowledge Keeper, Expert and Institutional Hearing on Sexual Exploitation: human trafficking and sexual violence. Fourteen witnesses brought a wealth of knowledge, evidence and different views on how to address sexual exploitation to the Commissioners, including legalization and the direct link between poverty and sexual exploitation.

The National Inquiry will hold closing submissions from Parties with Standing in two locations, from November 26 to 30, 2018 in Calgary, AB and from December 10 to 14, 2018 in Ottawa, ON.

Together we will find the truth, honour the truth and give life to the truth.
